

Uninstalling OpenVPN

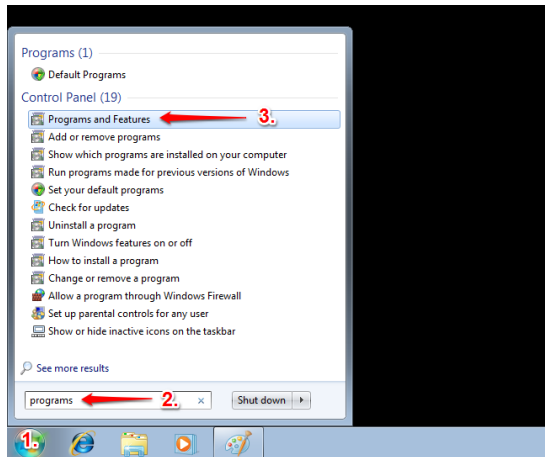


Overview:

This guide will show you, how to uninstall OpenVPN to make your system ready to use with the Viscosity VPN Client.

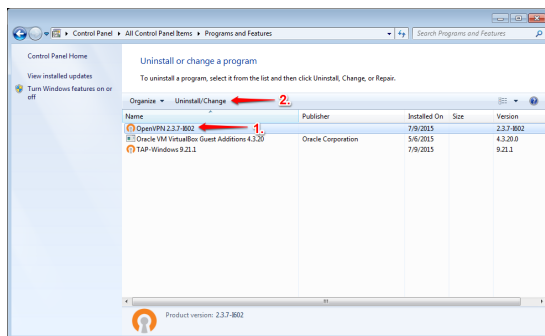
Requirements:

- PC with Windows and OpenVPN installed



Step 1

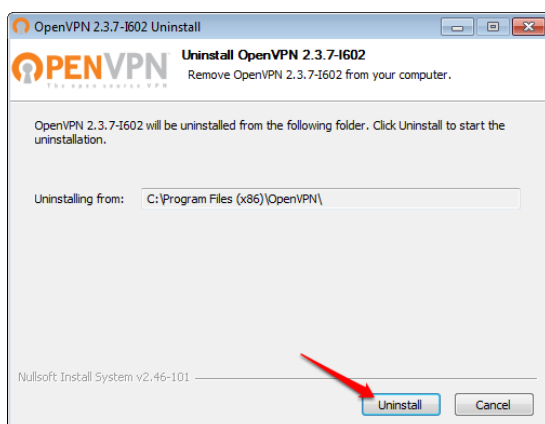
- go to the Control Panel and open 'Programs and Features'
- you can also use the search function in the Start menu
 1. click on the Windows logo
 2. enter 'programs' into the search bar
 3. from the results list, select 'Programs and Features'



Step 2

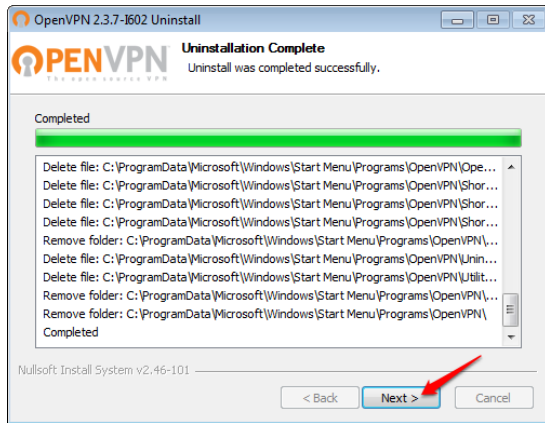
1. select 'OpenVPN'
2. and click on 'Uninstall/Change'

The OpenVPN version number can be different on your system.



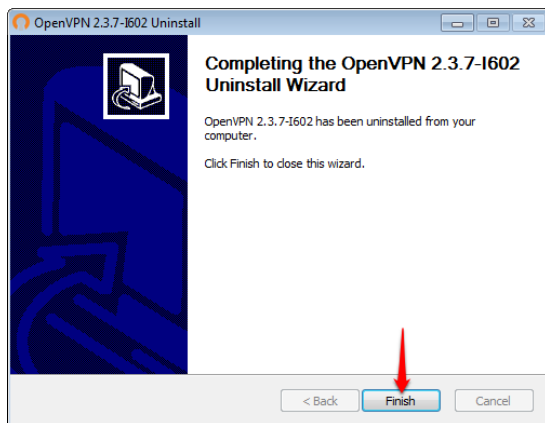
Step 3

- click on 'Uninstall'



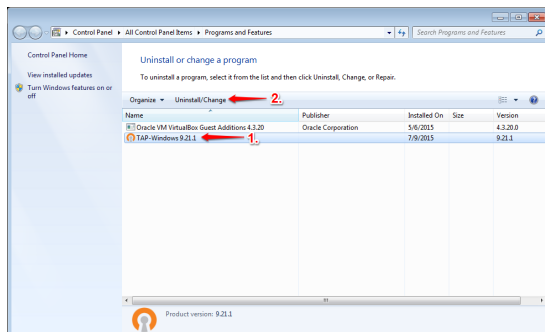
Step 4

- click on 'Next'



Step 5

- click on 'Finish'



Step 6

- next step is to uninstall the TAP Adapter
 1. in 'Programs and Features' select 'TAP-Windows'
 2. and click on 'Uninstall/Change'

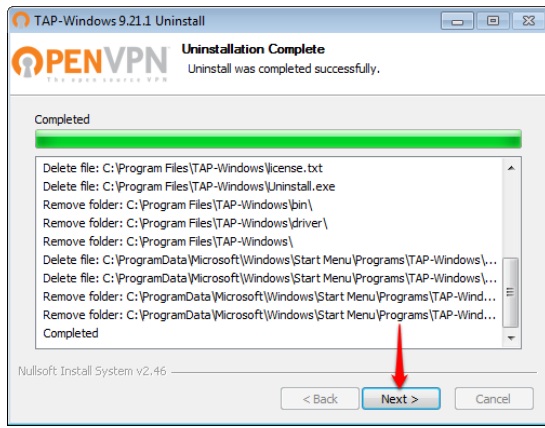
The TAP-Windows version number can be different on your system.

It is also possible, that there is no TAP-Adapter left on your system. In this case, proceed with step 10.



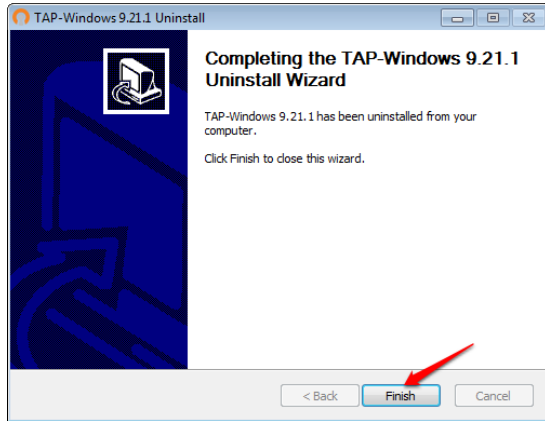
Step 7

- click on 'Uninstall'



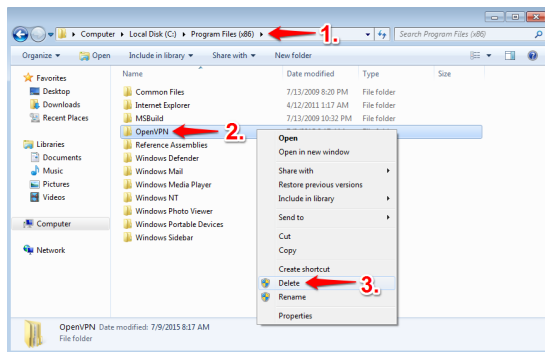
Step 8

- click on 'Next'



Step 9

- click on 'Finish'



Step 10

- Last step is to remove the unnecessary files that were left by the uninstall process
 - open the Windows-Explorer by pressing 'Windows-Key+E'
 1. navigate to 'C:\Program Files (x86)'
 2. select the 'OpenVPN' folder
 3. open the context menu by right-click and click on 'Delete'

Please restart your computer to complete the removal of OpenVPN!
